Five of our twelve are from outside FUMC -- making for great fellowship beyond our own walls. One of our group even took the idea and created a butterfly garden at St Theresa's!

With 14 raised vegetable beds and a very large pollinator garden for bees & butterflies, there's always tasks to do, keeping everything healthy and vibrant. We avoid chemical fertilizers and insecticides to ensure wholesome, nutritious produce for our neighbors who may pick as they walk by or may obtain from the Palatine Township Food Pantry where we deliver weekly.
