- A/V Team -

You may remember (like I do) the "Audio Visual" club from high school, whose members would spend their free time running slide projectors and movies for various groups at the school. Well, our A/V team is a lot like that, except our time is not just limited to Study Hall! And, of course, technology has come a long way since the days of the overhead projector.

The FUMCP A/V Team's main responsibility is to insure that the Sunday morning services are heard and seen well by those in the sanctuary, as well as those watching online. This includes running the slides for the overhead screen, the cameras for the live-stream, and the audio mixer for the overhead speakers and the Telecoil hearing assist system (the "Loop"). In addition, the team provides these same services for funerals, weddings, Scout ceremonies, and other events that take place in our sanctuary.

As you can imagine, there is a consistent need for service from the A/V team, which translates into a great opportunity for anyone reading this to help out - in other words, join the A/V team! The only prerequisite is a willingness to learn and help in this important area of our church's ministry. We'll provide all the training you might need. And if you aren't sure, then give it a try for a few weeks, and then decide after you've tried it and had a chance to see it all in action.
